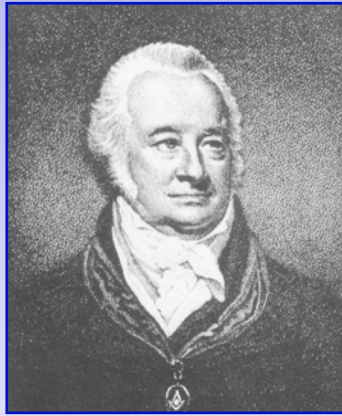

**The Subject: “Music in Masonry and beyond”
The Intent: “... to inform, educate and entertain, ...”**

The lecturer will be W Bro Wayne Buffett Warlow, MA. B Mus, PPIGW (South Wales), a well known Music Director, Conductor, Composer, Arranger, Producer and Presenter.

A multi-instrumentalist he has been involved in some 1800 film, television, and radio productions together with innumerable live performances, and theatrical performances with artists who range from Sir Geraint Evans to Tony Bennett and Dame Anna Neagle to Catherine Zeta Jones. He has been the Conductor of the BBC Radio Orchestra and has produced film scores which have won awards at the New Zealand Film Awards and the Monte Carlo International Film and Television Festival.

He summarises his lecture as follows “During the course of the presentation, well-known musical links to Freemasonry are of course covered and references made to many distinguished musicians who were also enthusiastic Freemasons.

The underlying thrust of the lecture however is far more broad and is in essence a non-technical and accessible examination of the nature of music itself and its often subliminal emotional and psychological impact on the human mind.

The intent is to inform, educate and entertain, the overall object of the exercise is to raise awareness of the underlying properties of music and to enable brethren to better appreciate how and why it enhances our ceremonies”.

This presentation of the 2010 Prestonian Lecture is being made in conjunction with the Annual Festival of the Federation of School Lodges.
